For your information: We cross check your Social Security Numbers with the Food Stamp Office in Oregon. If you are participating on both programs, you will be disqualified from food stamps and USDA program. The penalty will be to pay back the programs to cover the cost of the USDA food items or food stamps. This is being brought to your attention because of the dual participation within the programs.

PEAR CRUNCH

3 cans drained pears
1/4 cup brown sugar, packed
3/4 cup flour
3/4 cup sugar
1/4 tsp. salt
1/4 tsp. cinnamon
1 egg
1/3 cup melted butter

Mix pear slices with brown sugar in a baking pan. Set aside. Mix flour, salt, sugar and cinnamon. Set aside. Beat egg. Mix flour mixture. Spread over fruit. Pour melted butter over top. Bake at 375 degrees (moderate oven) about 45 minutes until lightly browned. Serve warm. Makes approximately 3 servings, about 3/4 cup each.
