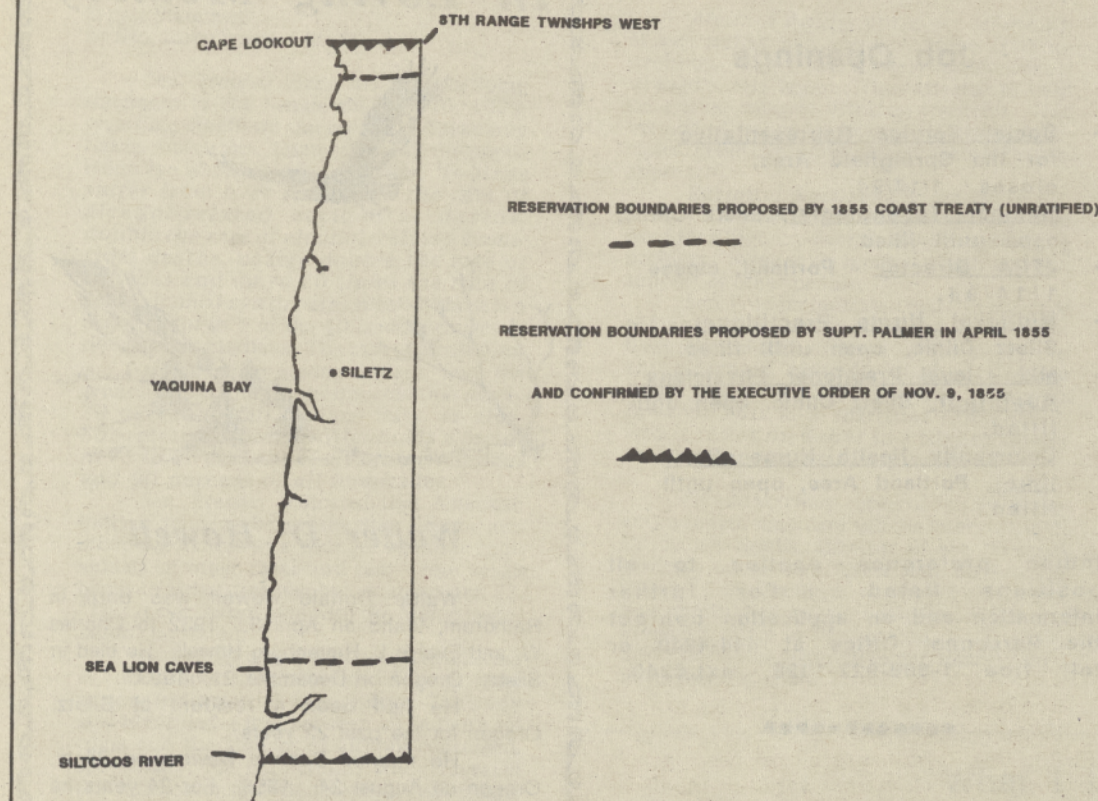

Questions Asked at the Candidates Fairs.....

- Per Capita Money? What do you mean by compensating? We have money now and are having problems now?
- How many people think it is important to answer letters written to the Tribal Council?
- Changes of the Constitution should be brought out to the General Council and brought to the floor. Also, why are issues not brought out into the open?
- Should employee issues be brought to Council? If there is a complaint against a tribal employee, what happens?
- Does the Council check to see if procedures were followed and if the chain of command was used first by employees before their issues were brought before the Council?
- What would your answer be to a "No Host Bar" at Tribal Meetings?
- What is your opinion of having staff members doing the leg work for consultation purposes versus hiring outside help?
- Do you think Tribal Council should stay out of administration issues and problems?
- How do you feel about giving up your private life - family dinners - occasions to go to meetings out of town or to be given a short notice to go to special meetings even though you have a job to go to?
- What do you envision doing that is new for the Tribal Members?
- How do you feel about extending Health Benefits and Education Services to Tribal Members who are outside of the Service Area?
- How do you feel about Tribal Staff working on Council?
- Do other tribes allow staff to be on Council?
- Where do you see it stated that a Tribal

Member that works for the Tribe cannot be on the Tribal Council? Is it written somewhere?

- Is this violating our rights as a Tribal Member or is this being a dictatorship?
- Why is our Tribal Council not working on our Water Rights?
- How do you feel about a full-time paid Council?
- How do you feel about changing the procedure of the Council Members evaluation of the CEO being open (visual) to the General Council?
- We've been talking about the Tribe's Sovereignty. What do you feel about the 25-40 year age group? What should we do for them?
- What are your thoughts on gaming?
- How many of the Candidates have attended all of the Candidates Fairs and how many have not attended?
- Would you as a Tribal Council Member be willing to donate your monies earned for attending meetings back to the Tribal Members?
- What is your answer to seeing the "For Sale" sign placed on an Indian Burial Site and also seeing the "Sold" sign that was displayed by Michael Berry?
- Michael Berry, do you have any other issues to express other than our Sacred Lands?
- What is the relationship between the Siletz Tribe - STEDCO - the Commissioners and the Tribal Council.
- Is STEDCO following the guidelines of our Tribe?

Blood Quantum Questions Asked:

- We have had families cut off of the enrollment list. How can we fix this so that this does not happen again as we need to look out for our children?

U.S. Department of Justice Grant

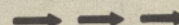
WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Office of the Sheriff states that the City of Siletz and the surrounding community is the highest total response area in Lincoln County; and

WHEREAS, the concern focuses on alcohol/drug related automobile fatalities on the highways, theft of property, safety of children and families, and acts of vandalism; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice through the Police Hiring Supplement Program, are targeting funds to localities most in need to provide incentive for communities to develop innovative, locally designed, long-term public safety plans; and

WHEREAS, the Siletz Tribe desires to participate in the competitive application process; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians of Oregon hereby approves submission of an application by the Planning Department to the United States Department of Justice to provide law enforcement protection for citizens within the Siletz Community.
