Policy Statement on Parking

At each of the offices with lined parking lots, there are designated parking slots for handicapped personnel and visitors. These are required by law and are to be used only by those individuals who have in their physical possession a handicapped sticker provided to them by the State of Oregon- Department of Motor Vehicles.

It is against the law to park in a designated handicapped parking space unless you have a handicapped sticker. If you choose to park in any designated handicapped parking space at the Siletz Community Health Clinic, the Community building, the STEDCO Office, the STEDCO Apartments, or at the Area Offices which violates the law, you will be subject to a \$250.00 fine.

Please realize these parking spaces designated for the handicapped are needed for their use, and should not be used by you for your convenience.
