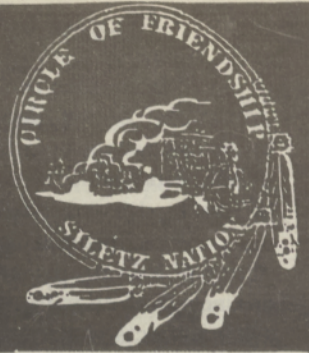

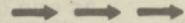
Siletz Gaming Project
