As most of you already know, we will soon be voting on whether the blood quantum for tribal enrollment will or will not be lowered. This is a very important election. It will be conducted by the Bureau of Indian Affairs by Mail in ballot ONLY. All ballots must be received by the Bureau no later than 2:00 p.m. May 23, 1995. The results may have dramatic effects upon the future of our Tribe. We are trying to reach as many of our voting age members as possible to give each and every one a chance to vote. Unfortunately it is difficult to find some of you! The following list reflects the names of those people for which we DO NOT have current addresses. Please send your new address to The Enrollment Department, Confederated Tribes of Siletz, PO Box 549, Siletz, OR 97380. Remember that for your own protection and privacy your address is confidential. For that reason, if it has been changed at the Health Clinic, Enrollment will not have that change and the opposite is also true. Each program needs separate notification.

I recently received a notice from the Bureau of Indian Affairs regarding an upcoming election to amend the Tribal Constitution. It stated that this will be a Federal Election, not a Tribal election. This could be misleading. What this means is that the BIA will conduct the election rather than the Tribal Election Board. They did not say what the election was for. It is very important for all of us to know what the election is for.

The election is to amend the Tribal Constitution to lower the enrollment blood quantum to one sixteenth (1/16).

Please make sure that you fill out the voters registration form and return it to the BIA so you can vote in the special Federal Election. Phil Rilatos, Sr.
