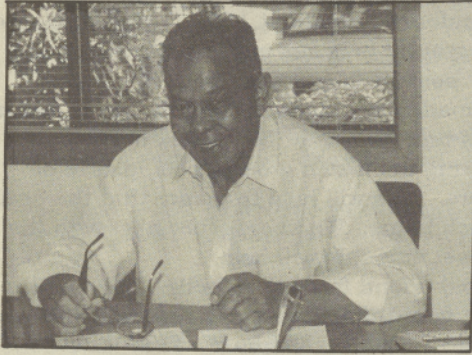


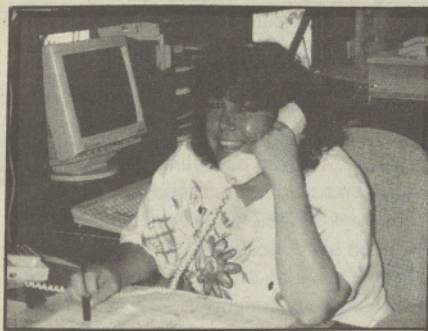

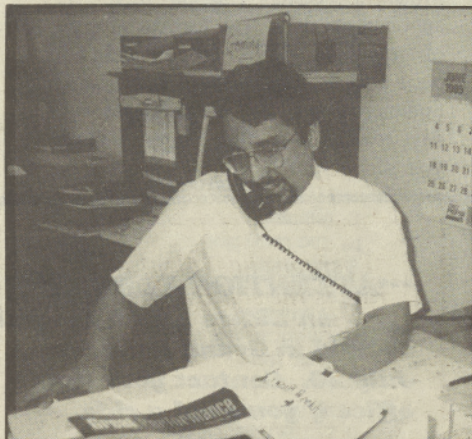

## HIP Program Report

In my short time working in the department I have realized my job position is very challenging and rewarding. I look forward to many more happy and enjoyable experiences with the Siletz Tribe. I thank everyone here for the warm and wonderful welcome."



We have completed applicant #0067 septic system project. The Lincoln County Sub-surface Depart-

ment stated on the inspection report that the workmanship was very good. A big "thank you" and congratulations to Mike Elkins Construction and Rairden Brothers Construction for a job well done.

We have secured three sewer systems and two water systems this year in the HIP program utilizing the new IHS Tribal procurement system for sewer and water projects. There are several wells which have been needed for many years. This summer will be my first attempt at hand dug shallow wells in the community. This is a last resort as the drilled wells in the Logsdan area have been unable to produce potable drinking water.

We have served everyone on the category "C" list that is eligible under the current guidelines for 1995 - a total of ten grants in all. Keep your eyes open for upcoming homebuyer seminars in the next issue of the newsletter. We will be scheduling seminars in all the area offices, so put in your requests for specialized information or housing topics you or your office would like to see. The past years have been very successful in providing the information needed to make informative housing decisions for you and your family.
