

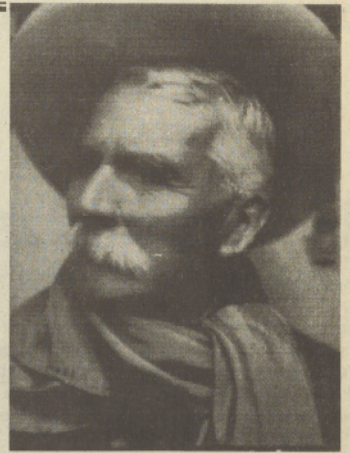
# GENERAL NEWS

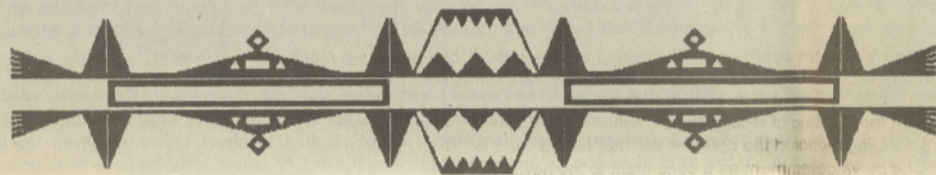
