Little River Band to Harmonize at Chinook Winds August 1&2
Concerts by the Sea will bring the Little River Band, one of the hottest rock groups to come out of Australia, to Chinook Winds August 1st & 2nd.
Success for the band began with the release of their debut album in 1976 : Not only has the Little River Band had a dozen top 30 hits including "Lonesome Loser", "Cool Change", "Take It Easy On Me", "Reminiscing", "Help Is On It's Way", "Lady", "The Night Owls" and "Man On Your Mind", they also have had five straight gold or platinum LP's.
Over 20 million records sold attest to the outstanding three part harmonies and powerful instrumentations of the Little River Band.

Tanya's career was launched two decades ago, with "Delta Dawn", her first hit, at the tender age of 13. Since then she's had innumerable hits, been the topic of conversation in many of the tabloids, became the mother of a son and a daughter, and has received a multitude of Country Music Awards. With 28 albums to her credit, and approximately 200 performing dates per year, Tanya continues to delight audiences all over the world.
"Soon", "Love Me Like You Used To", It's a Little Too Late", "Two Sparrows In A Hurricane", "Strong Enough To Bend", and "What's Your Mama's Name?" are just a few of her chart busting hits that span over twenty years of success in Country Music.

The Neville Brothers Bring a Unique Cultural Sound to Chinook Winds Casino August 29 & 30.

Drawing from every African-American musical style, from jazz and R&B, to reggae and Zydeco, Art, Charles, Cyril, and Aaron Neville have created a musical style uniquely their own. Since the '50's in New Orleans the brothers have been performing either individually or as a group until in recent years when they became reunited, including children and wives in their music, to make it a true family event, bonded with love. Their sound has grown and improved with time as is evidenced in their recent album, "Mitakuye Oyasin/Oyasin/All My Relations" (title approved by the Lakota nation Elders). This album stresses the Native American belief "that we are all one, and that we all need to work together for our own survival and the survival of the planet", a theme that is stressed through the songs and performances of the Neville Brothers.
The Band won a Grammy in 1989 for Best Instrumental with the song "Healing Chant" from the Yellow Moon album. Aaron achieved enduring pop stardom in 1967 for "Tell it Like It Is" and for his Top 10 duets with Linda Ronstadt, "Don't Know Much" and "All My Life," both Grammy winners.
There's no way to adequately describe the music and the style of the Neville Brothers. If you have never heard them perform, it's time to treat yourself to an experience you'll never forget. Find Out "If Bubba Can Dance" When Chinook Winds Casino Presents Shenandoah in Concert September 12 & 13

In 1987 Columbia Records released the band's first, self-titled album, Shenandoah. Since that time they have had 25 charted singles, 15 Top Ten hits and 11 #1 records. From their first chart-topping hit, "Church On Cumberland Road" to 1995's "Somewhere In The Vicinity of The Heart," the group has handled soulful, contemplative ballads and grin-producing toe-tappers with equal ease and expertise. Other hits include "If Bubba Can Dance (I Can Too)", "I Want To Be Loved Like That", "Rock My Baby" "Ghost In This House", "Sunday In The South", "Two Dozen Roses", and "Next To You, Next To Me".
Shenandoah has received numerous awards and nominations including: the 1991 Academy of Country Music Award for Vocal Group of the Year, 1991 Grammy Award nomination for "Ghost In This House", 1991 Country Music Association Nomination for Group of the Year, 1992 Country Music Association Nomination for Group of the Year, 1995 Country Music Association award for Vocal Event of the Year (with Alison Krauss) and nomination for Group of the Year, 1996 Grammy Award for Best Country Collaboration with Vocals for "Somewhere In The Vicinity of the Heart" and nominations for "Darned If I Don't (Danged If I Do)" and "Amazing Grace: A Country Salute To Gospel".

Over 13,000 people were on hand Saturday, June 28, to help celebrate the 1st Anniversary of Chinook Winds Casino.
June 28 marked the end of a month long celebration with over \$36,000 in prize money given away. Twelve drawings, each worth \$500, were held the first three Thursdays in June with the final 12 taking place on Saturday, June 28, ending with the \$10,000 grand prize. A local man, Alan Fagg from Otis, dropped his entry form in the drum for the Winner's Circle drawing and at midnight became the lucky winner of the \$10,000 Grand Prize.
