Navy Department. They may never have heard of two employees of the New York City Health Department named Hermann M. Biggs and William H. Park, who were responsible, respectively, for the first efforts to conquer tuberculosis and for the discovery of diphtheria antitoxin; of Marion Dorset, chemist in the Federal Bureau of Animal Industry, who discovered a method of preventing hog cholera which led to the finding that yellow fever, smallpox, and measles are caused by viruses, and whose work has been ranked with that of Pasteur and Koch; of another employee of the Bureau of Animal Industry for 46 years, John B. Mohler, who saved a good part of the nation's livestock when he detected the existence of various diseases in an importation of Zebu cattle quarantined in New York.

These are only a few of the government civil service merit system workers who have served the public well and

made large contributions to human progress.
