The annual meeting of the State Employees Credit Union will be held in the Capitol building Tuesday, January 30, 1945. One of the principal matters which will come before the meeting is a proposal to change the by-laws so that all employees of the State of Oregon will be eligible to become members, no matter where residing. At present membership is confined to those employees who reside in Salem or in Marion County.

A retirement system for Bremerton, Washington, city employees was recently authorized by ordinance. Under the plan, members can retire at any time after they have served 25 years and are past the age of 55, or when they are 62 years of age. Present employees, under the plan, are given full credit for prior service.
