Our new election of officers is in full swing with the returns to be announced at the next meeting.

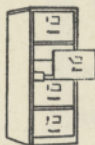
Tom Sims, a former Paving Crew Foreman, recently paid us a visit. Tom is working in Portland now and was here on a hunting trip.
