

to each member of the Legislature who supported, worked for and voted for the legislation sponsored by the Oregon State Employees Association: The Public Employees Retirement Act and the Civil Service Act.

The resolution was adopted.

Mr. Chidsey, chairman of the Constitution and By-Laws committee submitted his report as follows:

Two resolutions were submitted regarding the formation of a new district.

The committee did not have enough information to sponsor a concrete suggestion so recommended that this problem be submitted to the Board of Directors for action. The committee's report was adopted.

A resolution was submitted by La-Grande Chapter No. 4 to establish a uniform constitution and by-laws and uniform chapter dues for the several chapters.

It was the recommendation of the

committee that this do not pass because it was felt that it would infringe on chapter rights. The report of the committee was adopted and the resolution did not pass.

The following resolution regarding change of meeting date was presented to the council with the recommendation that it do pass.

Whereas: It is desired to hold our annual meeting prior to the State Legislative sessions which are held every other year in January,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** That the annual meeting of the General Council of the Oregon State Employees Association be held in November instead of February and to achieve this purpose the following amendment to the constitution and by-laws are recommended for adoption by the several chapters of the Association.
