All city employees except police, firemen and emergency crews probably will start working a five-day week on January 1, it was agreed by the council in conference Tuesday.

City Attorney L. E. Latourette will be asked to draft an ordinance cutting the working hours to 40 (they now work 44 and are paid for 48) and arranging that skeleton crews shall keep essential offices open Saturday mornings as at present. Those employees who work Saturday morning will get an equal amount of time off some other day.

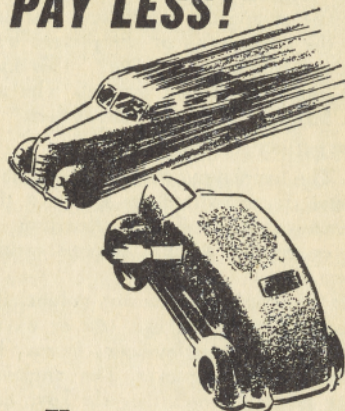
