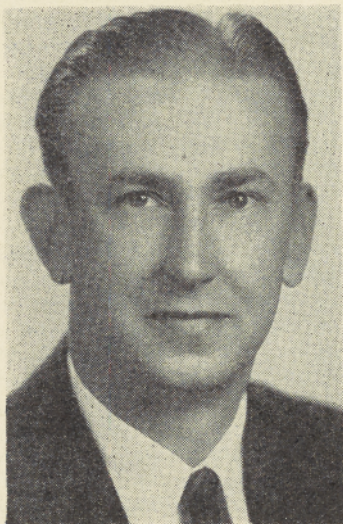


Introducing Your Association Officers
