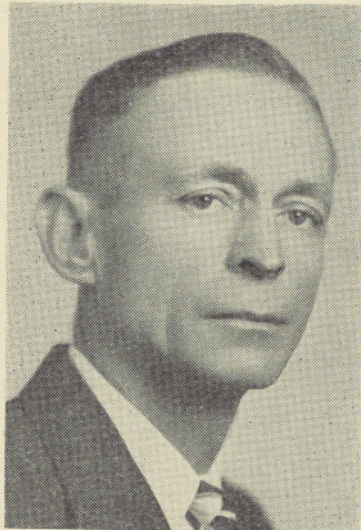

Bob likes fishing and golfing and does both with skill. He is a member

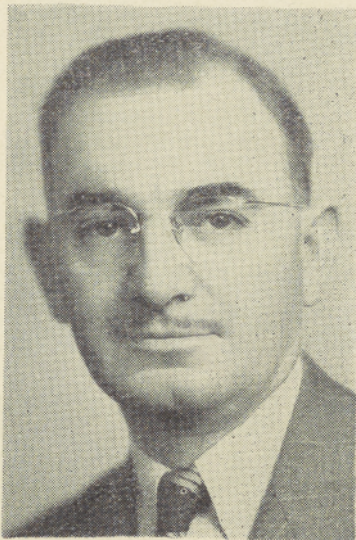
