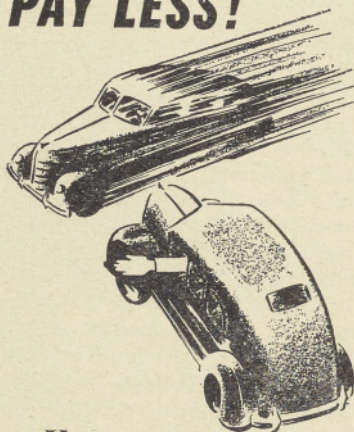
The Board of Control has not yet made any announcement concerning its decision on the 40 hour, 5 day work week requested.
