

PACIFIC COAST CHEMICAL PLANT WAGES HIGH

Straight-time average hourly earnings for a selected group of industrial chemical plants were revealed to be highest in the Pacific and Border States. This fact was published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics which surveyed 255 plants employing 64,340 workers. These plants represented about three-fifths of all plants with 8 or more workers and more than two-thirds of total employment in this branch of the chemical industries.

The Pacific coast high exceeded the Southeast, lowest wage region, by more than 50 percent. The Great Lakes and Southwest were slightly above the national average of \$1.14, whereas the Middle Atlantic and New England States were below. One out of three workers in the Southeast earned less than 65c on hour in contrast with 1 out of 40 in the Southwest and less than 1 out of 1,000 in the Pacific region.
