NEW YORK STATE EMPLOYEES GET OVERTIME PAY BOOST INSTITUTIONAL EMPLOYEES GAIN MOST

Under new legislation, New York state employees who work more than 40 hours a week will be paid for their extra time at straight hourly rates according to the Civil Service Assembly.

Institutional employees who work overtime will gain most under the new law. They now work 48 hours a week though they are paid monthly on the basis of a 40 hour week. Henceforth they will receive equivalent of another day's pay for the eight hours overtime.

All other employees who occasionally work more than 40 hours a week will be compensated either in time off or straight overtime pay for excess work hours. Appropriations of approximately \$11 million were made by the recent legislature for overtime compensation.
