#### MID-VALLEY SOCIAL WORKERS CHAPTER No. 32

Introducing Chapter 32!

Mid-Valley Social Workers chapter adopted its constitution at its third meeting, July 15, at a picnic in Leslie park. The chief points under discussion were—name and membership. The name, Mid-Valley Social Workers, was finally chosen, in order that employees of neighboring county welfare staffs might join if they wished, and so that social workers employed by the state in other than public welfare work might feel free to join. It was the feeling of the members that social workers and the staffs who assist them might want to discuss problems which would not be pertinent to other state employees. A name was, therefore, chosen which would indicate this limitation of membership.

At the first organizational meeting, on May 14, officers were elected as follows: President, Eileen Donaldson; vice-president, Margaret Maddox; sec-

retary, Nancy Graves; treasurer, Elmer Richards; delegate-at-large, Ruth Jaynes; alternate delegate-at-large, Olive Mallory.

At the second meeting, Mr. Forrest V. Stewart, executive secretary, spoke to the group on the techniques for forming a new chapter. He also described some of the accomplishments of the state organization and the methods used to achieve these ends so as not to produce hostility.
