

STATE BOARD HIRES PSYCHOLOGIST FOR TRAINING SCHOOL

The state board of control has voted to add a psychologist to the state training school for boys at Woodburn, but deferred action on a proposal to establish an educational program at the state penitentiary.

William G. Bolander, 42, Eugene, a University of Oregon psychology graduate, was appointed psychologist for the Woodburn school at \$240 a month to aid in boys' rehabilitation.

Prison Warden George Alexander asked approval of the proposed educational program for the prison in the belief it would aid in rehabilitation as well as prepare convicts for jobs on their release from prison. Action on this proposal was deferred.

A request by mechanical and clerical employees of state institutions that they be given a 40-hour work week, instead of the present 44 hours, was deferred to the emergency board, which would have to provide extra funds, since the proposal was estimated at \$23,000 annually. The employees contend they should be given the same 40-hour week as other state workers.—*Oregon Statesman*, July 23, 1947.
