He suggested that the General Council meeting for the coming year be held some place other than Salem and asked for invitations from outside localities. Because of the financial condition of the Association and the short period of time available for this year's meeting, a banquet would not be held and the only entertainment provided will be a social hour from 5:30 to 6:30 P.M., Saturday evening for the delegates, their wives and friends. The President stated that it was felt by the Association that it has accomplished a large number of objectives called for in resolutions presented during the last General Council meeting. Some things were not completed but most of the objectives are under way. It is regretted that with respect to the salary study the report was not released first, pending election on the sales tax and later due to the tragic death of Governor Snell, Secretary of State Farrell and President of the Senate, Marshall Cornett.

The Secretary-Treasurer read his report. Cash on hand as of January 1, 1947, \$1,251.83; during the period January 1 to October 31, 1947 chapter dues and initiation fees received, \$10,457.41; income from magazine, \$1,682.96; miscellaneous income, \$18.-32; loans from chapters, \$1,800.00; making a total income of \$15,210.52. Disbursements from January 1 to Oc-

tober 31, 1947, Salaries, \$5,350.00; legal, \$2,807.02; magazine, \$1,871.09; General Council, \$45.30; other travel expense, \$756.43; rent, \$240.00; miscellaneous expenses, \$2,050.02; making a total of \$14,540.93. Cash balance on November 1, 1947, \$669.59. It was moved and seconded that the report be accepted and the motion was carried.

Mr. Claude M. Johns, Director of Civil Service, was not present to make his report.

Mr. I. A. DeFrance, Director of Laws and Legislation Committee, presented his report in mimeographed form. Special commendation was accorded to Mr. Leo Smith, Legal Counsel, and Mr. Forrest V. Stewart, Executive Secretary, for their fine work during the last legislative session.
