

members on the books and at the end of the insurance drive they had 105 members all paid up and 83 signed up for the insurance program, an increase of 21 members. He feels their chapter qualified too soon, however, because five or six have approached the chapter for membership and insurance and now cannot come in without the medical examination. He stated there is an element in the state attacking the insurance program because it does not take in all of the employees, but so far he had not been able to contact any of the group to learn just why they oppose the program as set up. He said it had been suggested that we change our Constitution and by-laws to permit a new type of membership which would be purely a membership to facilitate the insurance program; that the chapter could be constituted a new chapter and be handled through the executive office; that it would have no voting rights and no participation in funds which may come back from the insurance company; that a charge similar to our initiation fee be made to those people on the basis of carrying the cost of the executive office and handling the insurance—could be \$1.00 or \$5.00. He said he didn't see why the plan had bogged down as it was too good for anyone to pass up.

Mr. Cameron wished to present a resolution in this respect but it was pointed out that it was past deadline set for introducing resolutions and the

council would have to vote on it. It was suggested that Mr. Cameron read his resolution which was as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED: That the General Council instruct the Board of Directors to provide for a new type of membership so all State Employees can participate in the Group Life Insurance program; whereby, a fee to cover administrative cost be paid and insurance granted any state employee who is not a member of the O.S.E.A. but otherwise qualified.
