BE IT RESOLVED: That all employees whose merit rating and length of service warrant it, be placed on the top bracket of the pay scale or on intermediate steps as their length of service and merit rating warrant.

Committee recommended that the above resolution do pass. Committee report adopted.

Resolution from SIAC Chapter No. 20, November 18, 1947. Committee passed it out without recommendation as they failed to contact representative of the chapter and were undecided whether increase in pay or return of price control was desired. After discussion, motion was made to table the resolution. Motion carried.

Resolution from The Dalles Chapter No. 9, with respect to pay adjustment to compensate for rise in living costs each six months. Inasmuch as the main resolution covers this subject, committee recommended the resolution be tabled. Committee report adopted.

Resolution from Albany Chapter No. 7, November 17, 1947, with respect

to exemption of state employees from paying state income tax. Committee recommended that it do not pass for the following two reasons: At the present time Federal employees, of whom there are more than state employees, pay state and federal income tax. Also it would be discriminatory among people employed by the state, for instance the school teacher, who would pay while other state employees would not. Committee report adopted.
