

who was not; that the Commission's budget would not allow such additional work; and that the Commission was not blind to conditions and personnel relationships in state service. He stated the Commission had gathered data on comparable salary rate conditions on a spot basis and had contacted the Bureau of Labor regarding statistics on cost of living situation. He said the problem is a general economic problem that in terms of its solution must lie with authorities higher than the Commission which has no appropriating power. The money for the salary plan was appropriated by the legislature and more money to effect a general adjustment must come from the sources which have authority to take such action.

A fifteen minute recess was declared to give the Nominating Committee opportunity to complete its work prior to noon adjournment.
