

ified and those chapters who have qualified will be opened without medical to those members who are not now insured, on the same basis as a new chapter: i.e. 75% of those not now insured;

That the actual cost of present contract would be \$1.41-\$2.00-\$2.21 as against \$1.15-\$1.48-\$1.79; however, the old rate will continue for one year and we have had the equivalent of a \$2600 dividend this first year in reduced rate. (Adopted by the General Council).

Report of Ways and Means Committee was presented by Virgil O'Neil, Chairman.

WM 1, Eugene Chapter No. 6. To increase membership dues. This was supported by several letters from chapters to finance the services of an assistant to the Executive Secretary. The committee considered all ideas and recommended that an assistant be engaged, but substituted a proposal that will appear in the budget. The Committee recommended that the resolution do not pass, but have included the hiring of an executive secretary's assistant in the budget. (Committee recommendation adopted).

WM 2, Oregon Chapter No. 22. Re: Board of Directors setting closing date for receiving resolutions and other

General Council business. (Adopted by General Council).

WM 4, Regarding loyalty tests for each employee. The State Administration or its legislative assembly conduct forthwith a loyalty test of each and every one of its employees and officers both within and without the classified service, and that the results of such investigation be published without delay. (Referred to Board of Directors).

WM 6, Interim committee appointed by the Legislature to study employee problems both as to wages, hours, working conditions, safety measures and effective efficiency. (Adopted by General Council).

WM 5, That the matter of recognizing Armistice Day as a legal holiday by the Boards of various schools be called to the attention of the Board of Higher Education and schedules be so arranged to allow employees holiday. (Referred to Board of Directors and Executive Secretary).

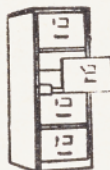
