Report of Constitution and By-Laws Committee was presented by L. A. McCoskrie, Chairman.

Mr. McCoskrie first took up the resolutions received too late to appear on the mimeographed agenda.

CA 5, That Section 5, Article 6, be changed to read, "Active members of the Association, other than those who have retired from the State service, shall be eligible to hold office during the succeeding fiscal year," (except as otherwise provided). (Adopted by General Council).

CA 6, That Article IV, Section (12) be added to read, "That a member of this Association loses his membership when joining any party of known subversive activities, advocating the overthrow by force of our National or State Governments." (Adopted by the General Council).

CA 7, To amend Article VII of the Constitution to provide for three new officers; viz: (1) Director of Membership, (2) Director of Retirement, (3) Director of Insurance and, that each proposed additional Director be voted upon separately by the several chapters. (Adopted by General Council).

CA 1, Columbia Chapter No. 34, RESOLVED, that an amendment to the constitution of the Oregon State Em-

ployees Association be made by striking out Section 2, Article IX. (Failed to pass).

CA 2, Columbia Chapter No. 34, RESOLVED, that an amendment to Section 1, of Article IX of the Constitution of the Oregon State Employees Association be made by the striking out of line one and portion of line two, composing the entire sentence—"The State Association shall be strictly non-political." (Failed to pass).

CA 3, RESOLVED, that an amendment to Article II, Objects, Paragraph 9, of the Constitution of the Oregon State Employees Association be made
