To stimulate a spirit of competition among the chapters of the association, to encourage intermingling of state employees from all departments to the end that they become better acquainted with one another, the Oregon State Employees Association has procured an attractive bowling trophy to be presented to the team placing 1st in tournament play-off of State Employees Bowling Leagues.

This trophy is to be a rotating award presented annually, for a period of 10 years, to the winning team. At the end of 10 years, it will be awarded, for permanent possession, to the team having won it the greatest number of times.

Competition for this award is open to any and all teams composed of state employees of Oregon, who are members of a chapter of the Oregon State Employees Association. It will be necessary, however, for participating teams to abide by the rules and regulations, governing bowling league play, as set forth by the American Bowling Congress.
