tax commission has requested that additional levels of calculating machine operators be established.

At its meeting on March 29, the civil service commission adopted new classes of Statistician IV, Hearings Officer III, Traffic Aide, and Potato Specialist. The Traffic Aide classification will be used in the traffic division of the highway commission and the Potato Specialist class by the recently established potato commission. The classes of Hearings Officer III and Statistician IV will be employed in several different departments. In addition, revisions of the classes of Statistician III, Hearings Officer I, Hearings Officer II, Sanitarian II, Forest Dispatcher, Forester I, Timber Cruiser and Game Biologist III were adopted. Salary changes included upward revision of the salary ranges for Medical Records Librarian I, Medical Records Librarian II, Medical Social Caseworker and Experimental Aide II. Specific information regarding these changes may be secured by writing the civil service commission.

Fund Accounting Class Underway

Twenty-five state employees are participating in a training course in fund accounting sponsored by civil service. The class will meet each Thursday for 10 weeks.

Examining Program Gains

With the change of status of hospital aide and practical nurse employees from conditional to trial service and regular during April as the

result of eligible lists being established following the recent examinations, nearly 60 per cent of the state employees will have been fully under the civil service examination program. A file count reveals that when this change is made 6,602 classified state employees will have trial service or regular status, whereas 4,786 will be conditional or provisional. This count excludes temporary, emergency and seasonal employees.
