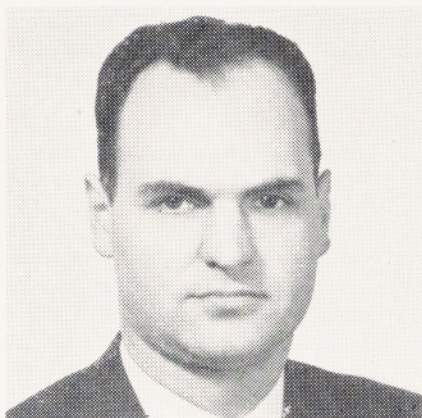


## *Here Are Your OSEA Officers*
