

Here Are the Rest Of Your OSEA Officers

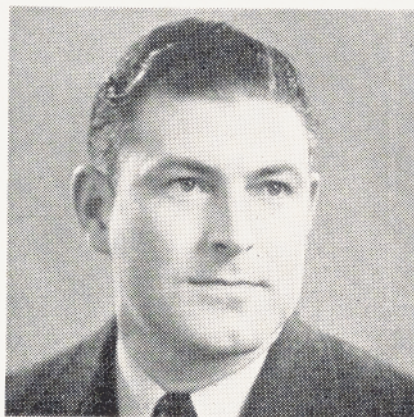


John A. Norton
