because such persons do not meet the definition of "war veterans" as contained in state law. However, any person called into military service from his state, county, or city employment, regardless of when, is considered to be on leave of absence and is entitled to reappointment to his old position without loss of seniority or other benefits, provided his military service was satisfactory and he applies for his old job within 40 days after discharge if a city or county employe, or within six months if a regular state employe.

Neither will he lose his retirement credits, but picks up where he left off when he returns to his job, although there is no provision as yet to enable him to continue making retirement contributions during his military service.
