

directly to anyone thereto entitled under the provisions of the retirement law, regardless of any claim maintainable against such sum thereafter in the hands of the recipient.

Rule No. 29

Investments of the retirement fund shall be carried on the books of the retirement system at their amortized values.

Rule No. 30

These rules hereby promulgated are intended as a revision of and restatement of all rules of the Public Employees Retirement Board and shall supersede all rules of this board heretofore filed with the Secretary of State.

Rule No. 31

In the event that a member of the system dies before retiring with no surviving next of kin as described by section 21, chapter 401, Oregon Laws 1945, as amended, and without having designated a beneficiary, the amount of money credited to his account at the time of his death shall be paid to the executor or the administrator of his estate. If his estate is not probated, such amount shall be held by the board in a suspense account not to exceed ten years, pending such administration or the appearance of next of kin. Thereafter it shall be subject to the laws of this state governing escheats.

Rule No. 32

The lump sum payment provided for by section 17, subsection 4, Oregon Laws 1945, as amended, made by an employe returning from the armed services to the employment of a participating employer other than the employer by whom he was employed at the time of entering military service, shall be credited to the employe's account with the employer by whom he was employed immediately prior to entering the armed services. Neither the act of returning nor the act of making lump sum payment shall be construed to provide service credit for the time nor service disability benefits for disability incurred during that period of service with the armed forces.
