Woodburn Paper Cited by NATO Defense Advisor

The Woodburn Independent, a weekly Oregon newspaper, earned international recognition for a civil defense test edition it printed in 1957.

So interesting was the test edition that it was described in the latest issue of a bulletin published in Paris by North Atlantic Treaty Organization. It's civil defense advisor, Sir John Hodsoll said, "Of the growing number of experiments in emergency journalism in the U. S., possibly the most interesting was the civil defense edition published under primitive conditions in July, 1957, by The Woodburn Independent."

"The editors (Eugene Stoller and Edward Coman) simulated loss of power and they demonstrated the emergency potential of the many small dailies and weeklies located outside of target areas."

The article included a photo of editors using hand-set type and a picture of the farm tractor used in powering a flatbed press.

PROFESSOR GETS TOP-POST HONOR

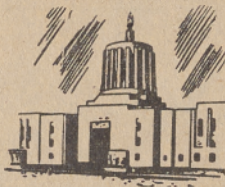

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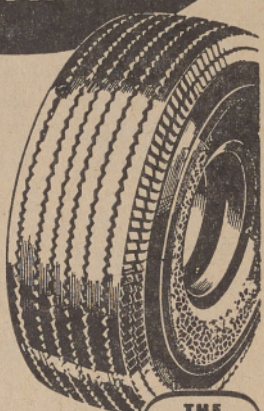
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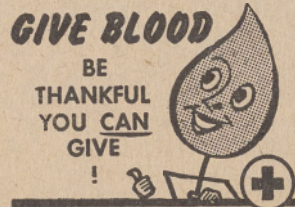
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
