CSEI Announces Rate Adjustments

The Insurance Committee announced this month that the Civil Service Employees Insurance Company rates for automobile coverage will be increased, effective August 1.

A Committee spokesman reported that the increases are more in the nature of adjustments according to territory to properly reflect loss experience in specific areas. Increases will be larger in the Portland and suburban areas and the remainder of the state will be somewhat smaller.

The adjustment will also be felt in the under-age principal male driver classification throughout the state.

The spokesman also said that since the rates are controlled entirely by the loss experience, the rate adjustments are intended to properly reflect the exposure, territory by territory and driver class by driver class.

"The OSEA has been able to retain the substantial savings that accrue to State employees after the August first date, however, a greater savings can be realized on insurance placed before that time," the spokesman added.
