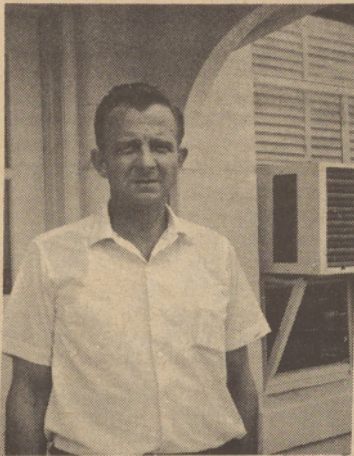


Elections Slated for District Candidates

District Director



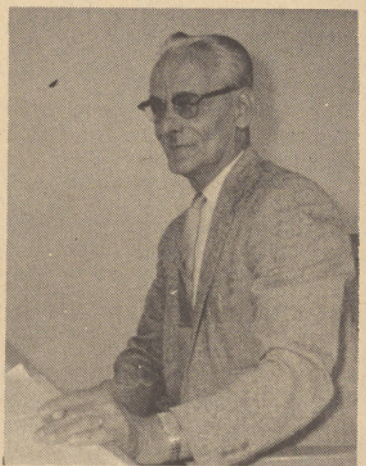

District Director

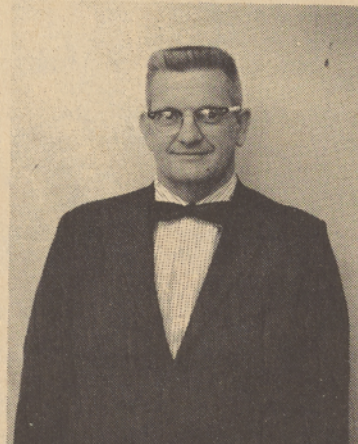

James D. Cunningham, member of Coos Bay Chapter 65. He has been President of Chapter 65 for the past year. (No picture or statement submitted.)

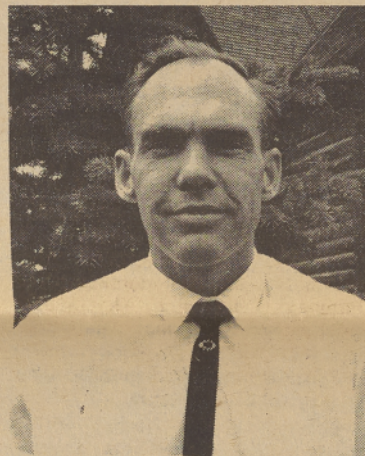

District Director

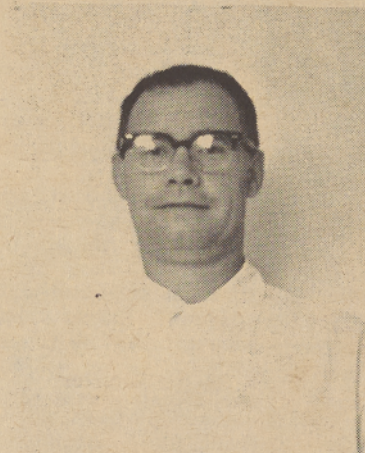

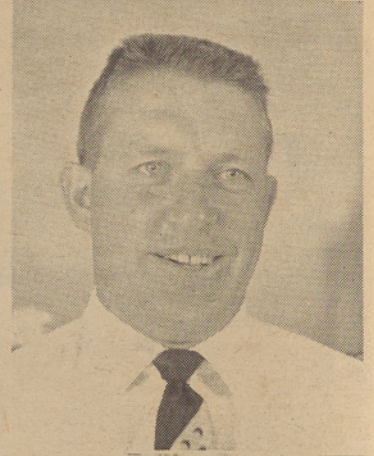
