OSEA Member Completes 46 Years Service

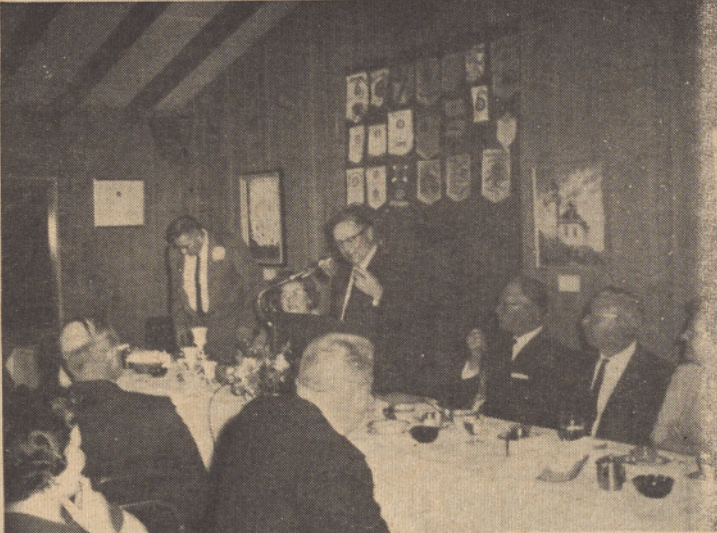

Lieuallen Talks Higher Ed Goals

Legislative goals for the 1967 session of the legislature were outlined by Dr. Roy E. Lieuallen, Chancellor of the State System of Higher Education, to members of OSU Faculty Chapter 72 meeting in Corvallis recently.

Among higher education's legislative goals is faculty salary increases, authority for the State System of Higher Education to participate in the payment of insurance premiums for faculty members and further improvements in PERS, Lieuallen said.

He said the PERS improvements include removal of the option to contribute on the minimum salary, improvement of benefits for those retiring in the next 10 years and a liberalization of the investment of PERS funds.

Lieuallen said some of the accomplishments of the 1965 legislative session in regard to faculty welfare included improvement of salary levels, authority to participate in TIAA-CREF and in tax-deferred annuity plans.
