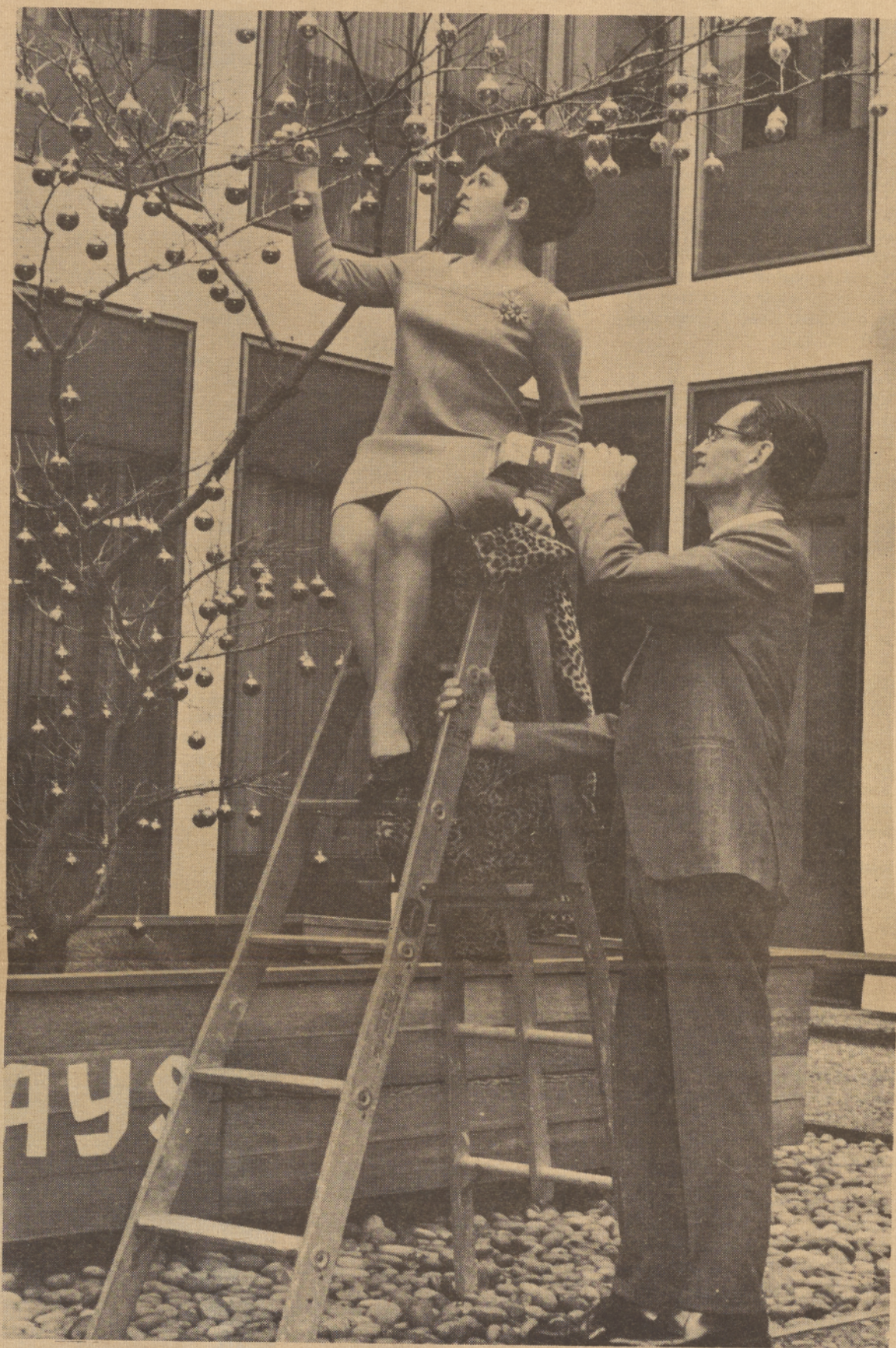


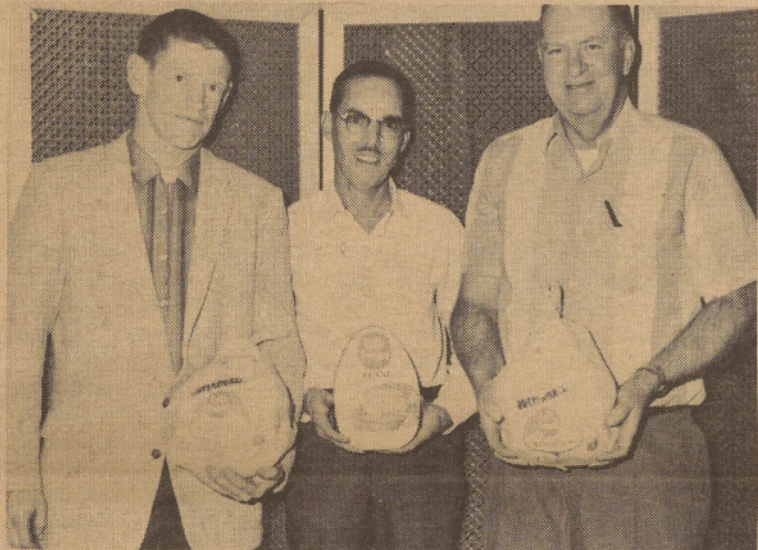
Sponsor Christmas Parties for Members

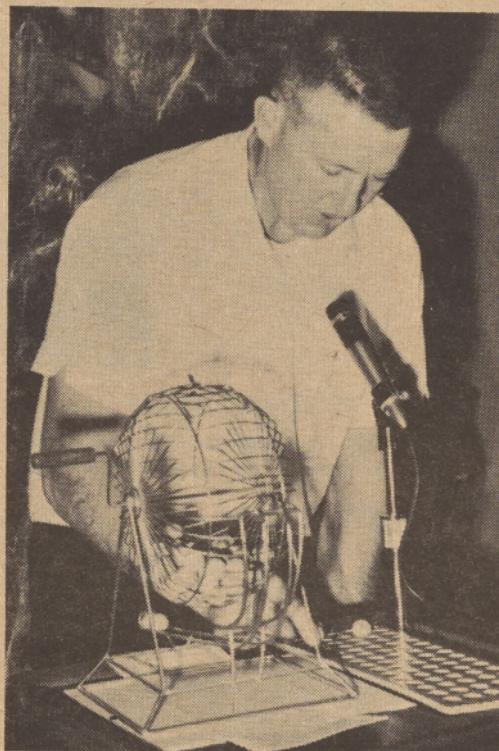
