

27 Awarded 'Employee of the Year' Certificates

"Chapter Employee of the Year" certificates will be presented to 27 state employees throughout Oregon in the first phase of OSEA's program to select a "State Employee of the Year" for 1968.

The certificates, signed by Governor Tom McCall, OSEA President Jerry Liebertz and the local chapter president, will be awarded later this month.

The program was initiated last year by the association's Public Relations Committee, headed by Ralston E. Smith.

Awards are made on three levels: chapter, district and state.

After their selection by local chapters, employees compete for the "District Employee of the Year" award. One will be chosen in each of OSEA's nine districts.

The "State Employee of the Year" will be selected from the nine district award recipients.

The state recipient will be named at OSEA's awards banquet in Salem January 25. Governor McCall will present the award.

District and state award recipients will be chosen by panels of non-state employee judges. Membership in OSEA is not required to be nominated or selected for an award at any level.

The 1967 "State Employee of the Year" was Mrs. Martha Collins, sponsored by Emerald Chapter 88, Eugene. She is an accounting clerk at the University of Oregon.
