SHOP AND FIELD CHAPTER 38 approved a motion to contribute \$50 to the association's scholarship fund at its January meeting.

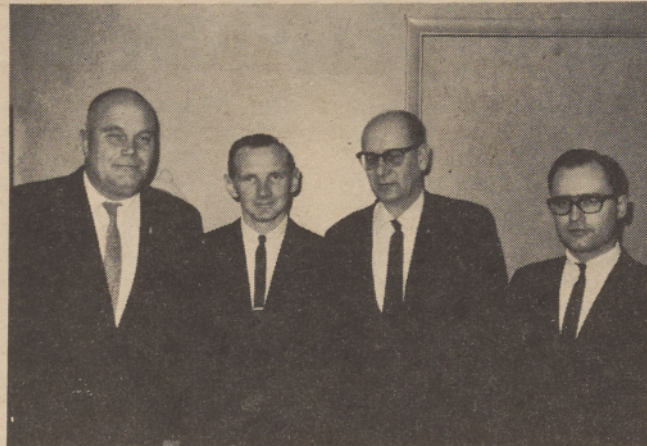
OCE CHAPTER 43's "Chapter Employee of the Year" is Dr. Ernie L. Cummins, professor of physical science at Oregon College of Education.
