

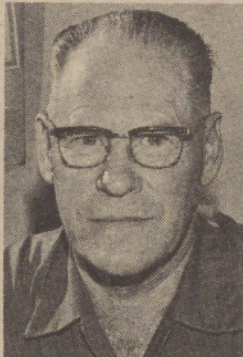
For Assistant Director

ROBERT ANDREWS

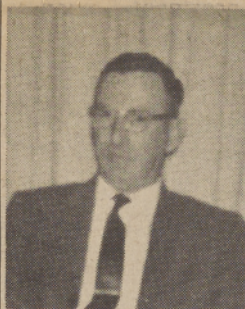

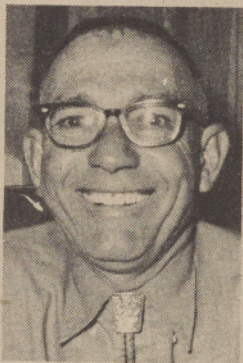


FERN STINSON

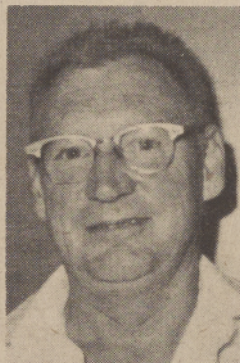

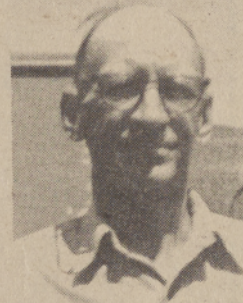

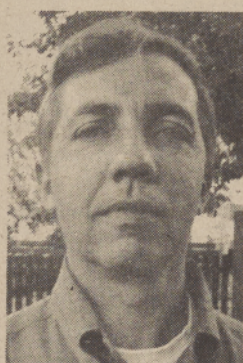
*District Nine**For Director*

CECIL BARNES

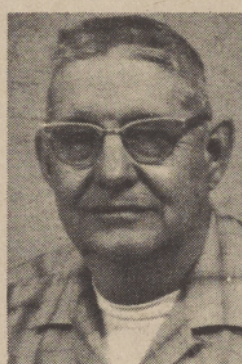
