

One Incumbent Defeated In OSEA's District Elections

Unofficial results of OSEA's statewide district elections show one incumbent director was defeated in her bid for re-election while five other incumbent directors were re-elected and three new directors were voted into office for one-year terms.

The upset occurred in District Six where Norman E. Boyles, a member of Webfoot Chapter 49 in Eugene, defeated one-term incumbent director Fern Stinson, Corvallis Chapter 29, and Fred C. Luke, Eugene Chapter 6, in a three candidate race.

Five other incumbent directors, including two who ran unopposed, were re-elected in Districts One, Two, Three, Four and Five.

In District One, Beth Brandes defeated George Gearhart. In District Three, Russell Blair edged James Cunningham. And in District Four, Paul Conner beat Harry Marshall. Ralph Jackson, District Two, and Donald Kelley, District Five, were re-elected without opposition.

Three new directors, two of whom were unopposed for office, were elected in Districts Seven, Eight and Nine.

In District Eight, Carey Huckba narrowly defeated Harold Hiatt for the office of director. Lee Roy Ryan, District Seven, and Cecil Barnes, District Nine, ran unopposed.

Six of the nine races for assistant director were contested. Richard Smith defeated David White in District One; incumbent James Kinns beat Dennis Thompson in District Two; Marian Lahr ousted incumbent David Henry in District Three; Wilhelmina Bevers edged Luther Steagall in District Six; incumbent Ray Karpen defeated Ronal Adams in District Eight and Walter Schmidt beat Stephen Waite in District Nine.

The three assistant directors who ran unopposed are Roy Simpson in District Four, Robert Andrews in District Five and Charles Bohannon in District Seven.

The 18 district officers will be sworn into office October 16 at the close of the 1971 General Council. The nine directors will be members of OSEA's 1972 Board of Directors along with 11 other officers elected by delegates at the convention.
