

Sam Hanson Named Member Of Phase II Advisory Group

Samuel G. Hanson, executive director of the Assembly of Governmental Employees (AGE), has been named to a special Phase II public employment committee by President Richard M. Nixon.

He is one of 19 committee members, including two governors, the President appointed to his Committee on State and Local Cooperation.

OSEA supported Hanson's appointment through telegrams to Oregon's congressional delegation and presidential advisors.

The committee was appointed to advise the Cost of Living Council and assist the Wage Board and Price Commission in the total effort toward economic stabilization through the encouragement of state and local governmental support of "voluntary cooperation."

In addition, it is referred items and issues which require special consideration on matters concerning stabilization of wages, salaries, prices, rents, taxes and fees as they relate to state and local jurisdictions and their employees.

At one of its earliest meetings, the committee recommended establishment of a separate wage review category for state and local governmental employees.

"Current arrangements for reviewing wage increases in the private sector do not readily meet the needs of state and local governments with their particular problems of

equity with the private sector," the committee said in a letter to the President's Wage Board. As yet no action has been taken on the recommendation.

Hanson, 59, has been AGE's executive director for seven years. He also is executive director of the Western Association of Governmental Employees (WAGE) and holds the same title with the Associated California Employees (ACE). He will continue to serve in these positions while on the President's committee.
