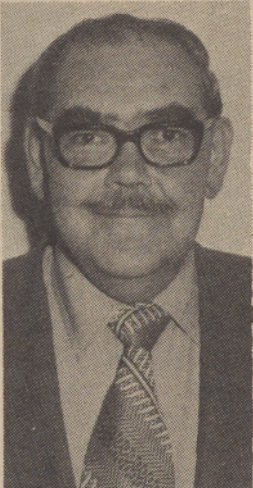


OSEA Schedules Elections for District Candidates

District One

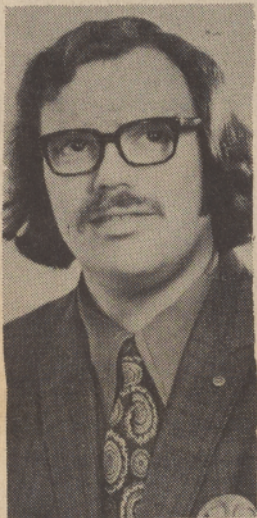
For Director

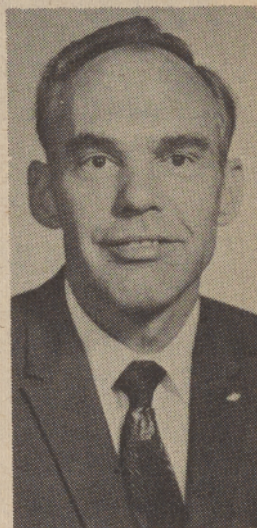


PAUL CONNER

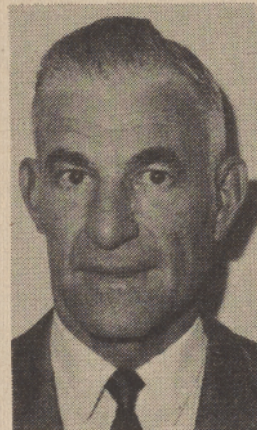
For Director
