**Editor's Note:** Blue Cross received a total of \$3,579,399 in premiums both from the state and its employees during the first six months of the state's health insurance program, according to Insurance Manager Ralph Bolt. In addition to the \$2,021,510 in paid claims, however, Bolt said Blue Cross had to set aside \$1,297,882 to pay pending and unreported claims and \$194,719 for the cost of doing business.

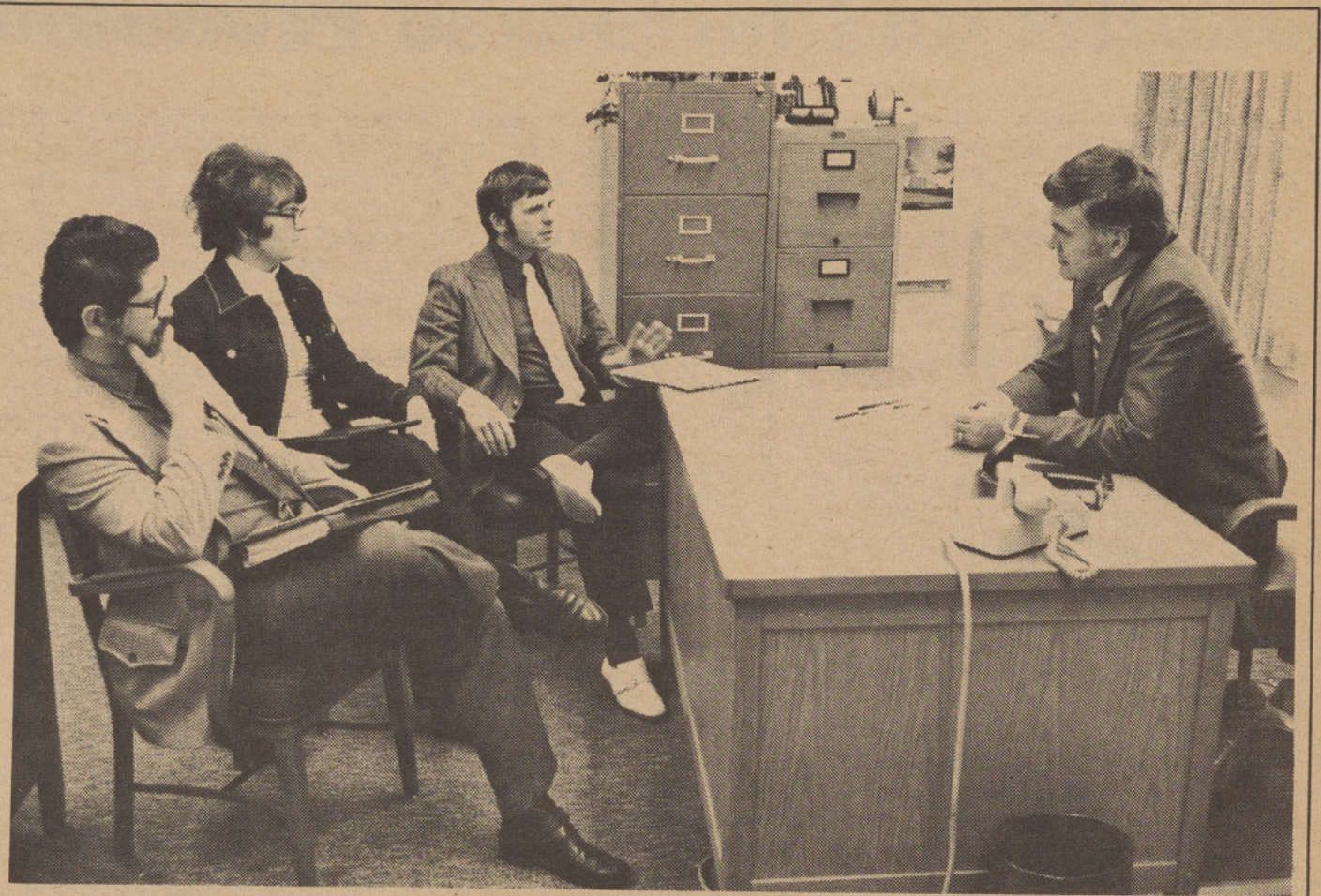
### Retirement Analysis Due
