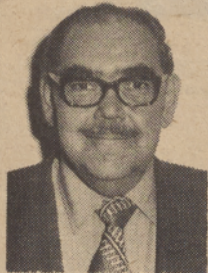


OSEA Schedules Elections for District Candidates

District One

For Director



MARTIN

DONALD A. MARTIN, Success Chapter 30, Portland. Incumbent. Presently completing his first term as director of District One. He has served one term as assistant director, one term as president of Success Chapter 30 and four terms as a delegate to General Council.
