I am writing in regard to the comments made in one of the statements printed in your June publication concerning the closure of Columbia Park Hospital and Training Center.

Jo Anne Jewell, psychiatric aide, Pritchett Cottage, Columbia Park, stated in her comments: "Last year we got a group of children from Fairview Hospital in Salem. They were considered untrainable. Now, however, they are practically trained."

The point I want to make is that we employees at Fairview consider each and every one of our residents "trainable." We feel there is no such thing as an untrainable mentally retarded person and to prove it we have designed training programs for all levels of retardation.

Although I sympathize with Columbia Park in their problem as I have visited their grounds and found them to be beautifully equipped for the most part to train the mentally retarded for community living, I sincerely feel that the "mud slinging tactics" to make Fairview Hospital and Training Center look inferior to be in bad taste and unfair. Our psychiatric aides at Fairview are dedicated and hard working people, too. They are for the most part working very hard at training efforts for the mentally retarded people in their care.
