Candidate for President



LESTER B. STRICKLER

Strickler presently is completing his first term as vice-president. He has served three terms as director of insurance and for the past 16 years as a delegate to General Council. He has served one term as president of OSU Faculty Chapter 72 and two terms as president of Corvallis Chapter 29. Statement: "My OSEA activity is truly a labor of love and this is a basic feeling I have about this organization. If elected president, one of the main things I want to do is to have our Association's leaders carry out a review of our different programs. In this way, all members' attention can be focused on the need for looking at various possible changes. JAMES J. KINNS

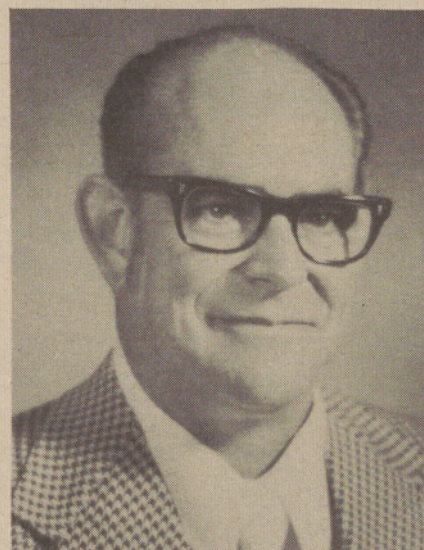
