JAMES A. REDDEN
State Treasurer

Richard B. Kinnersley, executive director of the Utah Public Employees Association in Salt Lake City, Utah, will speak during the luncheon on Friday, October 19. The subject of his address will be political action by public employees. He served two terms as president of the Western Region of the Assembly of Governmental Employees (WAGE), in 1971 and 1972. He is a graduate of the University of Utah with a master's degree in industrial relations. He has been executive director of UPEA for the past five years. Prior to that he was executive director of Junior Achievement in Salt Lake City.

State Treasurer James A. Redden will address delegates during opening day ceremonies, Thursday, October 18. He was elected state treasurer in 1972. Prior to that, he served three terms in Oregon's House of Representatives in 1963, 1965 and 1967. He has served as Medford municipal judge pro tem and Jackson County district judge pro tem. He was a member of the Public Employee Relations Board from 1969 to 1972. He was chairman of Gov. McCall's Task Force on Collective Bargaining in the Public Service that drafted House Bill 2263, Oregon's new collective bargaining bill for public employees.
