General Council Adopts 50 of 79 Resolutions

Editor's Note: A total of 79 resolutions were submitted to OSEA's 1973 General Council. Of that number 50 were passed, 9 failed, 2 tabled, 2 withdrawn by the sponsoring chapter, 13 held in committee and 3 referred to the Board of Directors for action. Those resolutions that were passed or referred to the board are listed on the following four pages. Due to space restrictions, only the "be it resolved" portion of each resolution is listed. Resolutions that did not pass, or were withdrawn, tabled, or held in committee are not listed. Academic and Unclassified

Academic and Unclassified No. 1. Subject: Scholarship fund participation. Submitted by: District One Presidents' Council.

Be it resolved: That the scholarship fund guidelines be changed so that any OSEA member may nominate themselves or one other individual of their choosing.
Action taken: Passed.

Academic and Unclassified No. 2 (amended). Subject: Rules on faculty records. Submitted by: OSU Faculty Chapter 72.

Be it resolved: That OSEA continue to initiate and support legislation to amend Chapter 566, Oregon Laws 1971, whereby an individual faculty member would always have the right to examine his complete personal records and that no records could be concealed at any time from the individual about whom these records are made.

Action taken: Passed as amended.

Academic and Unclassified No. 3 (amended). Subject: Resolution regarding academic salaries. Submitted by: OSU Faculty Chapter 72.

Be it resolved: That OSEA study and recommend a uniform academic salary schedule that would assure upward progression on a cost of living basis as well as a reward for longevity, experience and merit.
Action taken: Passed as amended.

Academic and Unclassified No. 4 (amended). Subject: Sick leave policy for academic and unclassified personnel.

Be it resolved: That OSEA study and propose a sick leave policy for academic and unclassified personnel employed by the State of Oregon and vigorously pursue the adoption of the sick leave policy.

Action taken: Referred to the Board of Directors as amended.

Academic and Unclassified No. 6. Subject: Initiate legislation to enact the uniform probate code. Submitted by: Board of Directors.

Be it resolved: That OSEA go on record as favoring amendments to Oregon's probate law designed to
