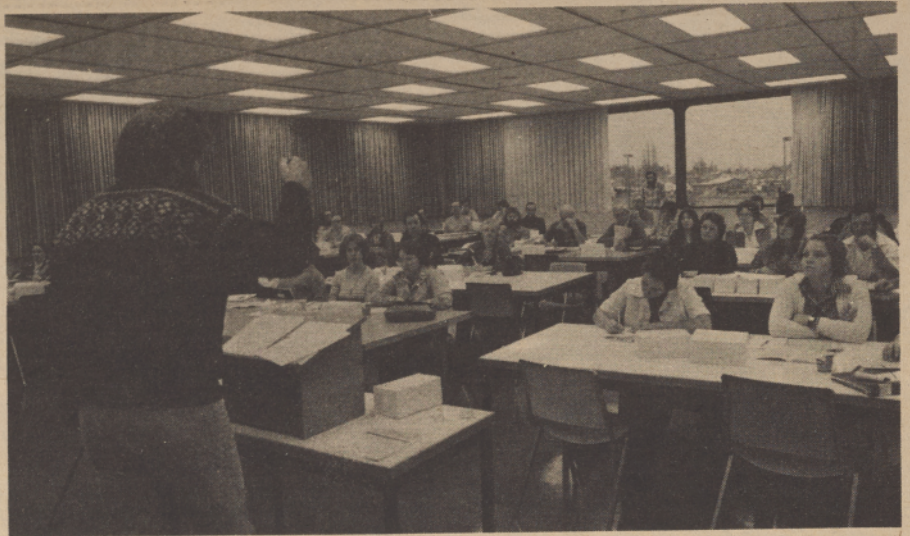

Members working on Salem diabetes project

SALEM -- To get public employes active in the community, to get some publicity and because "we wanted members to look outside our own problems," OSEA District 11 (Capitol Mall employes) have undertaken to help purchase a diabetic detection and education van for the Salem Hospital.

The district has planned a yard sale from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, June 3, in the parking lot of OSEA Headquarters.

The district has been working on this project under the direction of LeAnn Gilmer, project chairwoman and assistant director. The district wants to raise \$5,000 toward the purchase of the van. Presently it has about \$1,000 in pledges and \$300 from District 11 chapters that have raised money from their own fund-raising activities. This will be a continuing project for District 11, Gilmer says, because it plans to contribute to the operation for the van.

The district chose the diabetes project because, as Gilmer says, "there are a lot of fables and horror stories and we wanted to educate the public on the harm and control of diabetes." She says she didn't realize it was a handicap that could keep people from such things as getting a job or adopting a baby.
